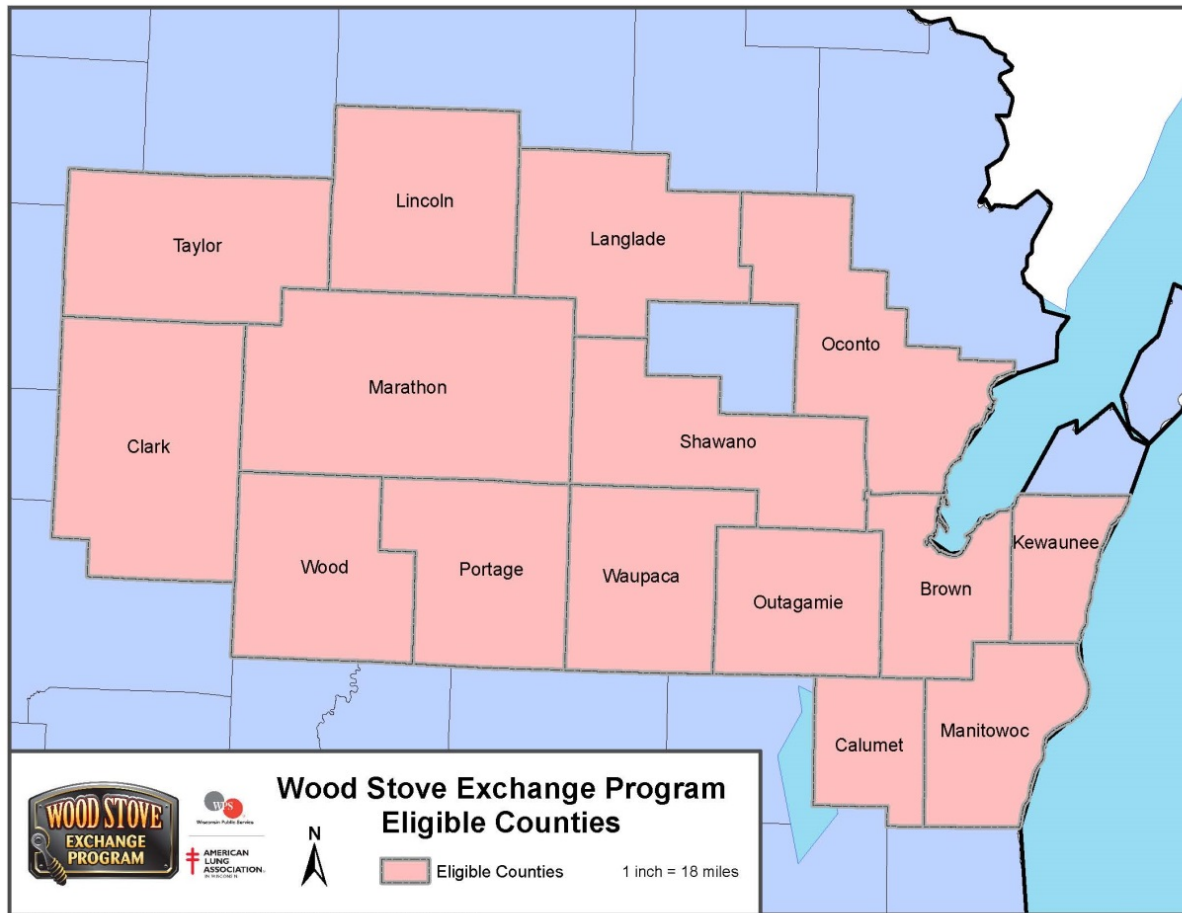


Program Overview



- **Program Objectives:**
 - Achieve reductions in fine particle matter and/or hazardous air pollutants
 - Increase energy efficiency
- **How:**
 - Replace/upgrading inefficient, higher polluting appliances with cleaner burning appliances and technologies.
 - Financial incentives ranging from \$325 - \$10,000 for residential customers only
- **Types Of Incentives:**
 - General residential rebate
 - Income qualified rebate
 - Primary and secondary residences qualify. Priority to primary residences
 - \$750,000 - \$2,000,000; funds available until exhausted, or 3/7/16, whichever comes first.
- **Appliance Qualifications:**
 - Appliance being replaced must currently be used as the primary source of residential heat.
 - Appliance being replaced must be a non-EPA certified or non-qualified appliance.

Geographic Area



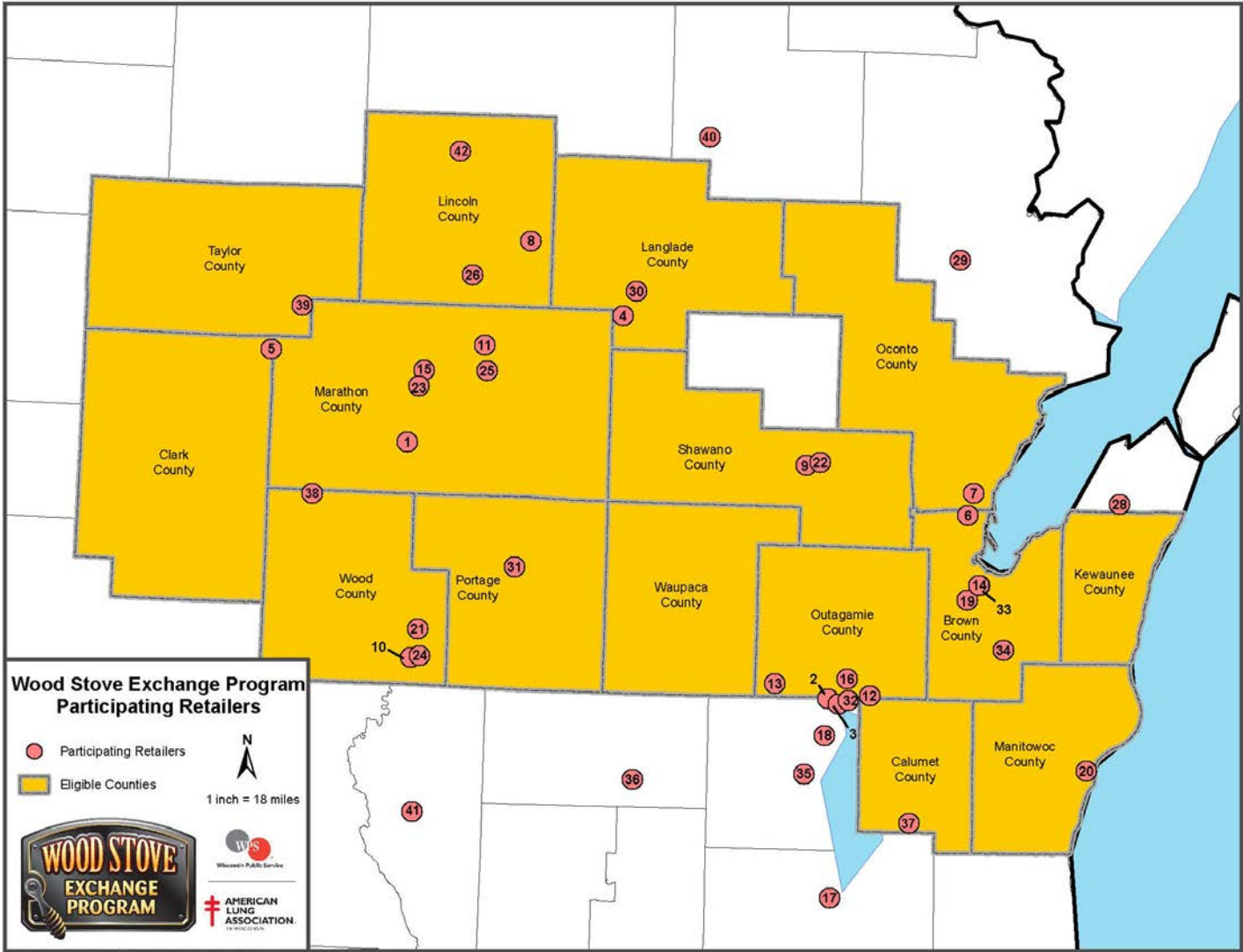

Additional Requirements



- Customer must surrender old appliance to be properly disposed of at a recycling facility.
- Installations and upgrades must be done in accordance with any applicable state, county or local municipal codes/ordinances and manufacturer installation instructions.
- New appliances must be installed by a certified professional, eg:
 - Licensed plumber or HVAC installer
 - National Fireplace Institute® (NFI) professional
 - Chimney Institute of America (CSIA) professional
 - Certified electrician
 - Commensurate for the work being performed.
- Only vented gas stoves allowed
- Open hearth conversions or gas log sets not allowed.

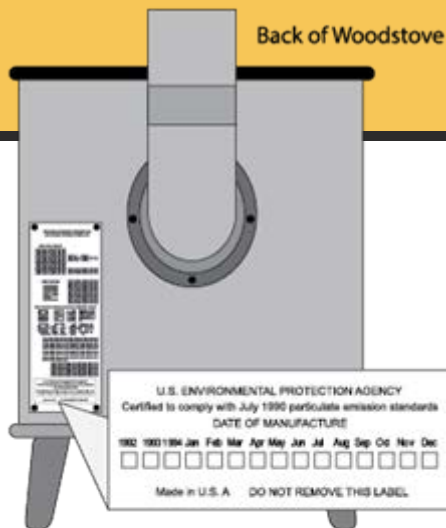
Eligible Appliances

4. Catalyst Replacement
